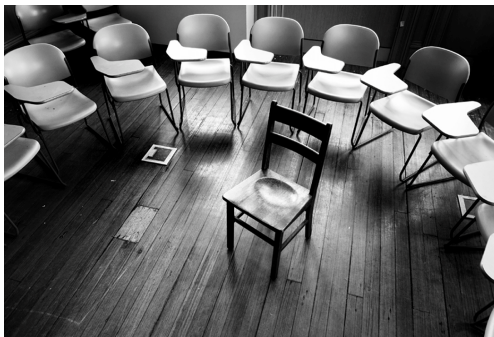


FACILITATOR TRAINING WORKSHOP
