- Linda Duncan has not sponsored any private Members' motions in the current session
- Duncan was the only non-Conservative MP from Alberta from the 2008 election until the 2015 election, and is still the only NDP MP elected in Alberta
- Before politics, Duncan practiced as an environmental lawyer, working in Edmonton until 1987 when she moved to Ottawa to work for Environment Canada
- She also spent time in Whitehorse working as an assistant deputy in the Yukon government
- She worked in Montreal in NAFTA's Commission for Environmental Cooperation
- She also served on the Sierra Legal Defence Fund's Board of Directors
- She attended the University of Alberta, graduating from their law school
