- After Premier Lougheed retired, Ron accepted the position of Trade Director of Western U.S. Operations in Los Angeles for Alberta Economic Development, from 1986 to 1991
- In 1991, Ron joined Telus
- Returning to politics in 2004, Ron sought and won the provincial riding of Calgary-West
- He served as a Member of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta from 2004-2012
- In 2014, Ron ran for the Conservative Party of Canada nomination in the newly created riding of Calgary Signal Hill
- Ron has served as a director of the board of Calgary's Pinebrook Golf Club and the Slopes Community Association
