- Francis Scarpaleggia has sponsored Bills:
 - C-326 An Act to amend the Department of Health Act (drinking water guidelines)
- Francis Scarpaleggia has not sponsored any private Members' motions in the current session
- First elected to the House of Commons in 2004, Francis Scarpaleggia was re-elected to Parliament in 2006, 2008, 2011 and 2015
- Francis has made the protection of Canada's freshwater a personal priority
- He initiated a study by the House of Commons environment committee into the impact of the oil sands on Canada's water resources and wrote the Liberal report from the study
- Francis was also a founding member of the all-party Parliamentary Committee on Palliative and Compassionate Care
- The committee wrote a report titled *Not to be Forgotten: Care of Vulnerable Canadians*
- Francis taught business administration at Montreal's Dawson College
- He spent several years working in the private sector, including as a corporate financial analyst
- Francis did his undergraduate work in economics at McGill University and earned a master's degree in economics from Columbia University, in New York
- He also obtained an MBA from Concordia University
