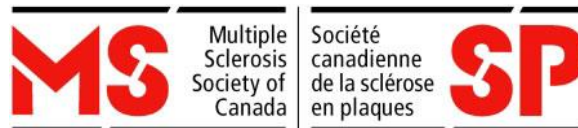

- Sweet owned and operated a tow truck business in Mississauga, Ontario from 1978 through the early 1980s and lead a real estate brokerage during the 1980s building boom
- Sweet owned a management consulting firm, which he operated for 17 years based on his experience in his previous business ventures
- Sweet was the founding President of the Canadian Association of Professional Speakers, an organization that provides training opportunities for and promotes professional speakers
- Mental health is an issue that Sweet has repeatedly spoken about, particularly after the death of his daughter Lara in 2017
- He called upon the Government of Canada "to continue to adequately fund the Canadian Mental Health Commission" and "to be generous to the Canadian Mental Health Association and others who are deeply committed to the fight for mental wholeness."
