



Submit an abstract to ACTRIMS to be considered for an MS Society of Canada endMS Research and Training Travel Award

ACTRIMS (Americas Committee for Treatment and Research in Multiple Sclerosis) Forum 2016 is taking place on February 18-20, 2016 in New Orleans, Louisiana. The theme of this year's [ACTRIMS meeting](#) will be “Progressive MS: Bench to Bedside and Back.”

The MS Society of Canada (MSSC) will be offering the endMS Research and Training Travel Award to **four (4) currently funded MSSC doctoral candidates and postdoctoral fellows who have submitted a successful abstract to ACTRIMS Forum 2016**. In order to be considered for this award, you must first submit an abstract to ACTRIMS by the submission deadline.

The deadline to submit an abstract is **Tuesday September 15, 2015**.

In order to be eligible for the MSSC endMS Research and Training Travel Award, you must meet the following criteria:

- Hold an active endMS Postdoctoral Fellowship or Doctoral Studentship

Award with the MSSC.

- Submit an abstract that is accepted for presentation at ACTRIMS Forum 2016.

The \$1,000 Award will partially cover travel and accommodations, and ACTRIMS will provide free registration for Travel Award winners.

Further details about the application process for the Travel Award will be available in November once ACTRIMS releases notification of abstract results.
